The Physical Therapy program at C.M.U. is a Doctoral Degree Program. You will pursue a Bachelor Degree in a different chosen field other than Physical Therapy. This is a limited enrollment program. The Reading placement test may be waived if you show documentation of a proficiency level 1 or 2 on the high school MEAP or MME writing and reading tests or if you have an ACT composite score of 22 or greater. The Mathematics placement test may be waived if you show documentation of a score of 28 or above on the ACT Math test.

Students may show Chemistry 100Lec & 100A proficiency by passing the Chemistry Placement Test. Call 777-0394 for an appointment.
