English, Reading, Mathematics and Chemistry Placement Tests may be required and are available in Testing Services, located in Room 134 – 777-0394. English and Reading placement tests may be waived if you show documentation of a proficiency level 1 or 2 on the high school MEAP or MME writing and reading tests or if you have an ACT composite score of 22 or greater. The Mathematics placement test may be waived if you show documentation of a score of 28 or above on the ACT Math test.

Students desiring an Associate Degree from M.C.C. should consult a counselor.

Students should check the M.C.C. catalog for course prerequisites.

TRANSFER POLICIES

1. Credit will not be transferred for any course lower than a “C” (2.00 gpa). For further information please contact the Admissions Office at KCAD.
2. Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University reserves the right to make curriculum changes without notice statements.
3. A minimum of 120 semester credits including those credits transferred from Muskegon Community College are required for a Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree. A minimum of 30 semester credit hours must be completed in residency at KCAD for the B.F.A. and B.S. degrees. All students must earn at least 50% of their studio major at KCAD. Refer to the college catalog for graduation requirements.
