*Prospective students should plan on transferring to W.M.U. after one year. For transfer students to stay on track they should apply to the School of Nursing by the March 1 deadline of their freshman year. This would allow them to take the Introduction to the Profession of Nursing course the first semester of their sophomore year.

Students are advised to consult the W.M.U. catalog in regard to specific requirements for their nursing program.

English, Reading, Chemistry, and Mathematics Placement Tests may be required and are available in Testing Services, located in Room 134 or call 777-0394. English and Reading placement tests may be waived if you show documentation of a proficiency level 1 or 2 on the high school MEAP or MME writing and reading tests or if you have an ACT composite score of 22 or greater. The Mathematics placement test may be waived if you show documentation of a score of 28 or above on the ACT Math test.

Students should check the M.C.C. catalog for course prerequisites.
