Do I Qualify?

You qualify for this scholarship if the following criteria are met:

- Your high school overall GPA is 2.0 or better
- Your Health and/or Physical Education G.P.A. is 3.0 or better
- You have not previously been enrolled at Muskegon Community College, except as a high school guest student
- You have an interest in or intend to pursue a career in the Health (health teachers/athletic training only), Physical Education or Recreation field
- You have two letters of recommendation

What Courses Will I Be Expected To Take?

You must take one course in the area of Health, Physical Education and Recreation each semester while you are on scholarship. Other courses may be taken to fulfill your own preferences or to meet graduation requirements. You must maintain a minimum of three credit hours while on a Performance Based Scholarship.

Is The Scholarship Renewable?

Yes. Providing you maintain a 3.0 GPA in the Health, Physical Education and Recreation area and an overall 2.0 GPA, it is renewable up to 62 credits.

What If I Have Already Received Other Scholarship or Grant Monies?

The amount of this scholarship varies but will not exceed the cost of tuition when coordinated with other awards you may receive.
