## **Muskegon Community College Intramural Basketball - 3 on 3 Basketball Rules**

The MCC Intramural Sports **3 on 3 Basketball Rules** are based on the **NCAA Collegiate Basketball Rules**. Some of the more important rules as well as rules unique to the MCC Intramural Sports Program are included herein. All players are responsible for reading this document before participating in 3 on 3 Basketball.

**Conduct and Disqualification:** Good sports conduct is essential in Intramural Sports contests. Therefore, if a player or players are suspended from a game, they will receive a minimum, automatic one game suspension. The suspension of that player becomes effective immediately following the ejection and carries through the remainder of that game, and the following game.

**Picture Identification Is Required:** All participants must be prepared to show Game Officials a valid Student ID Card or a current Drivers License in order to participate in Intramural Sports. Individuals without current picture identification will not be allowed to participate. A team unable to field a minimum number of players with picture identification will forfeit the contest.

### **HOW TO ENTER**

The deadline for the 3 on 3 Basketball is Friday, February 14, 2009. The cost is \$20.00 per team. To enter, request an official registration form in the PE Office Room 801.

**Eligibility for Intramural Sports:** You must be currently enrolled as a MCC student, staff or faculty member to participate. Basketball players presently playing on the MCC men's or women's basketball are not eligible to play.

**THE GAME:** 3 on 3 Basketball is a half-court game. All games are self-officiated. Offense calls the fouls.

**NUMBER OF PLAYERS:** No team may have more than four players on their team roster. Three players shall constitute a team. No team shall start a game with less than two players.

**BASKETBALL:** Teams can check out a basketball with the tournament director with a valid photo ID.

**LENGTH OF GAME:** Each game shall last 15 minutes; at the conclusion of 15 minutes of play the game is tied. The overtime period will be 3 minutes. No specific margin of victory is required.

**SCORING:** All baskets shall be worth one point or two points behind the 3 point arc.

**CLEARANCE:** Following a defensive rebound, the ball must be cleared to a distance equivalent to the top of the key in any direction from the basket. A shot taken and converted without proper clearance shall not count, and the offensive team shall retain possession.

**INBOUNDING:** After a made basket, the defensive team shall obtain possession. All in-bounds must be checked by the defensive team.

**VIOLATIONS, FOULS, and OUT OF BOUNDS:** All violations and fouls will result in the opposition of the team committing the infraction obtaining/retaining possession of the ball. The opposing team shall inbound the ball at any position behind the three-point line. Any ball going out of bounds shall also be in bounded from any position behind the three-point line, regardless of where the ball went out of bounds.

**TIME-OUTS:** Time-outs may only be called for injuries or by the official scorer and only during a dead ball situation, or after a made basket.

### **PRIZES**

Champions and runner-ups in each division will receive MCC Intramural t-shirts.
