Education is an investment in yourself

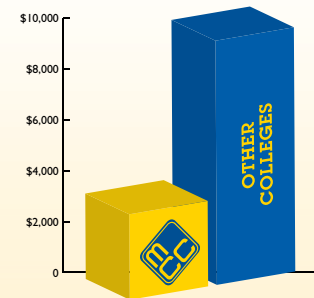

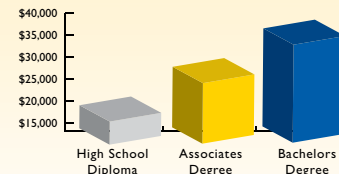
