Women Win MCCAA/Region XII Bowling Championship; Men's Team Places Second
The MCC women’s bowling team successfully defended its MCCAA/Region XII Championship title while the MCC men’s bowling team surged to a second place finish on February 12 at Merri-Bowl Lanes in Livonia, MI. Both teams have qualified for the NJCAA national championship on Feb. 25-27 in Cheektowaga, NY.

“The women’s team won it going away,” said Coach Bill Bowen. “They had the lead after doubles and singles events and never relinquished it.” The Jayhawks easily took top honors with 6,881 pins, followed by Schoolcraft with 6,516, Kirtland 5,210 and Wayne 4,325. MCC qualified for the NJCAA national championship on Feb. 25-27 in Cheektowaga, NY.

A trio of MCC women bowlers captured All-MCCAA medalist honors: Nicole DePender (Oakridge HS), Shelby Castenholz (Ravenna HS) and Candace Sutter (North Branch HS). DePender was the all-events champion, repeated as the singles champion, and teamed with Sutter to take second in doubles. Castenholz took second in all-events, third in singles, and teamed with Alexis Carpenter (Central Lake HS) for third place in doubles. In addition to her doubles’ second, Sutter took fourth in all-events and fifth in singles.

“The men’s team came from behind in dramatic fashion,” said Bowen. “After doubles and singles, they trailed by 130 pins. Heading into Baker games, they trailed by 110 pins. Heading into the last two Baker games, they trailed by 10 pins. In Baker game number 7 of 8, they posted a 196 to take the lead with only one Baker game remaining. They held on to secure a second place finish and qualify for nationals.” Jayhawk men’s bowler Mark Edens (Muskegon HS) earned All-MCCAA Medalist honors for his second place finish. MCC’s Trey Guzman (Ravenna HS) placed sixth in singles.
