Men's and Women's Bowling Nationals Hosted By Erie Community College

Muskegon Community College had three men and two women qualify to compete at the NJCAA National Tournament hosted by Erie Community College in Buffalo, NY.

In the Men's All Events (12 games) Josh Kohlbeck (Reeths-Puffer HS) finished 32 out of 98 bowlers, Trey Guzman (Ravenna HS) finished 36th and Vincent Birch (Brighton HS) finished 42nd. In Men's Singles (3 games) it was Kohlbeck in 11th, Birch in 26th and Guzman in 66th. Guzman and Birch finished 12th out of 45 teams in Men's Doubles (3 games).

In the Women's All Events (12 games) Mady Bacon (Mona Shores HS) finished 36th of 79 bowlers with Jessica Kinnucan (Western Michigan Christian HS) at 38th. In the Women's Singles (3 games) Kinnucan was 37th and Bacon was 41st. In the Women's Doubles (3 games) Bacon & Kinnucan finished 19th out of 35 teams.

Birch (Brighton HS) finished 6th overall for the men and received All-Conference and All-Region XII honors. Mady Bacon (Mona Shores HS) finished 8th overall for the women and received All-Conference honors. Josh Kohlbeck (Reeths-Puffer HS) finished 5th in provisional. Trey Guzman (Ravenna HS) finished 11th overall.
