Jayhawks wrap up season at Lansing Community College

Muskegon Community College lost their last 2 games of the season at Lansing Community College, 12-0 (5 innings) and 12-3 (5 innings).

Hannah Smith (Montague HS) picked up the only hit for the Jayhawks in game one. MCC's defensive problems continued with 5 more errors.

Game two saw McKayla Greiner (North Muskegon HS) and Allyssa Bobian (Montague HS) each pick up 2 hits but errors again cost the Jayhawks and spoiled strong pitching performances from Bri Breen (Allendale HS) and Allison Shafer (Whitehall HS).

The Jayhawks ended the season with a 10-24 conference record and 14-32 overall.

Jayhawks split with Kalamazoo Valley Community College

The Muskegon Community College Jayhawks split a doubleheader with Kalamazoo Valley Community College, winning game one in 8 innings 1-0 before dropping game two 5-0.

In game one Kirsten Sweet (Fruitport HS) threw a gem in the victory, scattering 6 hits in the complete game shutout. The game was scoreless through 7 innings but Grace Hall (Mona Shores HS) singled in Hannah Smith (Montague HS) with 2 outs in the bottom of the 8th for the walk off victory. Smith led the Jayhawk attack with 2 hits.

In game two the Jayhawks were held to 2 singles, 1 each from Grace Hall and Morgan Taylor (Orchard View HS). Bri Breen (Allendale HS) pitched a strong game, only giving up 6 hits and 1 earned run but the Jayhawks defense committed 5 errors.
