

WOMEN'S INDOOR TRACK AND FIELD 2019-20 RECAPS

Track & Field at GVSU

Muskegon Community College wrapped up the 2020 indoor track and field season with a meet at GVSU.

The women's team got a strong performance from Rebekah VanDeweg (Spring Lake HS) who finished 2nd in the high jump with a mark of 1.56m, just missing the National qualifying standard of 1.61m. She also ran a personal best of 9.63 in the 60m hurdles, good for a 4th place finish. Also running their personal collegiate best in the mile were Adele Cory (Mona Shores HS) in 5:44.32 and Hannah Finkler (Reeths-Puffer HS) with a 5:53.70 (12 seconds faster than her previous best). Haylee Ray (Grand Haven HS) also ran her personal collegiate best in the open 800m with a 2:30.96.

The Jayhawks will now focus on training to be ready for the start of the outdoor season on Saturday, 3/28 at Indiana Wesleyan University.

The women's track team traveled to University of Findlay this weekend to compete against the other NJCAA teams in our region.

Rebekah VanDeWeg (Spring Lake HS), Haylee Ray (Grand Haven HS), Grace Sweet (Reeths-Puffer HS) and Raegen Lockhart (Reeths-Puffer HS) ran the distance medley relay in 14:05.12. Ray and Sweet also competed in the open 800m run coming in at 2:34.67 and 2:37.63 respectively. Ray posted a season and collegiate best time. Lockhart competed in the mile as well, completing her race at 5:45.37. Also competing in the mile were Adele Corey (Mona Shores HS) in 5:55.87, and Hannah Finkler (Reeths Puffer HS) in 6:03.15. Vandeweg also competed in the high jump (1.52m) and the 60HH (10.09).

Rebekah VanDeWeg (Spring Lake HS) was busy all night as she placed 4th overall in the 60 Hurdles (9.63), 4th in the High Jump (1.50m/4'11"), and 11th in 200m. She also helped her teammates on the 4x400m relay with an 8th place finish. The highest finish of the evening came from Grace Sweet (Reeths-Puffer HS) with a 3rd place effort in the 1000m (3:22). Adele Cory (Mona Shores HS) and Hannah Finkler (Reeths-Puffer HS) had strong finishes in the mile with an 8th and 9th place respectively. Haylee Ray (Grand Haven HS) raced to a 6th place finish in the 600m (1:51) and Alyssa Hussey (Reeths-Puffer HS) also competed in the 600m.

The track team travels to Findlay Ohio in two weeks to compete at Regionals.
