Tuition Award Guidelines 2018

DRAWINGS WILL BEGIN AT 1:20 P.M. Must be present to win!!

The recipient of this award is entitled to 2 years “free” tuition towards a degree at Muskegon Community College In-County Rate (please see * below). The recipient will be responsible for the cost of books, supplies, and other fees.

Registrant must be at least a current high school freshman to enter the drawing.

The recipient will be required to apply for financial aid and to submit all required documentation for that application process by the required deadlines. If eligible for financial aid, that assistance will first be applied toward the student’s direct costs.

In the event that the winner is not able to use the scholarship, it may be transferred (one time) to the winner’s designee. Any transfer of this scholarship award must take place at least 30 days before the transferee begins classes at Muskegon Community College. Once the award recipient or transferee begins using this scholarship at MCC, the award is then non-transferable. This award has no cash value and may not be sold or redeemed in any other way. The required paperwork will be completed and kept on file in the Muskegon Community College Financial Aid and Financial Services Offices.

This award will not pay for the re-taking of classes or classes not required within the program of study.

Tuition is payable under this award 4 years after the recipient or transferee enrolls or until the recipient/transferee has attempted the total number of credits required by his/her chosen program, or until the total value of the award is exhausted, whichever comes first. The recipient or transferee must activate this tuition award by June 1, 2022. The tuition award will not be able to be used after June 2, 2022 if activation has not taken place.

Muskegon Community College employees and their immediate family members (spouse, dependent children or grandchildren) are ineligible to receive this award. Likewise, this scholarship may not be transferred to MCC employees, their spouse, dependent children or grandchildren.

Current or past students may apply this scholarship towards unearned credits only. This scholarship may not be used to reimburse credits already earned.

YOU MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN!

*Tuition award is limited to an amount equal to 62 credits at current in-district tuition rates (\$113.50 per contact hour). As of October 2018, this equals \$7,037 (for 62 credits).
