During the 2011 season the Jayhawks were Conference Champions, finished 3rd in the MCCAA State Championship and finished runner-up in the Regional 12 Championship while compiling an overall record of 32-12.

Prior to coming to Muskegon Community College Rick was the Head Coach at Davenport University from 2006-2009 where he started the volleyball program in 2006. During his time at Davenport Rick had 9 players receive all conference awards and in 2009 started a JV program.


