Women's Cross Country 2015-16 Recaps

Cross Country at the NJCAA Nationals hosted by Iowa Central Community College

The Jayhawks finish in 22nd place out of 42 teams.

The Muskegon Community College women's cross country team finished 22nd place out of 42 full teams with 556 points on Saturday at the NJCAA National Cross Country Championships held at Lakeside Municipal Golf Course in Fort Dodge, Iowa. Leading the Jayhawks was freshman Sandy Kunnen (Fremont HS/Fremont, MI) finishing 80th place out of 303 finishers with a time of 20:28. Sandy's 80th place finish at nationals was the 5th highest women's national meet finish ever for MCC. Following Sandy were freshman Mckaya Groenwald (Bear Lake HS/Bear Lake, MI) finishing 94th place, freshman Breunisje Kass-McGrady (Western Michigan Christian HS/Ravenna, MI) finishing 106th place with an all-time personal record of 20:49, sophomore Marlee Harris (Buckley HS/Buckley, MI) finishing 159th place, freshman Maddie Hodges (Hart HS/Hart, MI) finishing 173rd place, sophomore Raquel Zavala (Muskegon HS/Muskegon, MI) finishing 204th place, and sophomore Sabrina Smith (Hart HS/Hart, MI) finishing 263rd place. Coach Fishel commented "When it comes to team scores, 22nd place is our 2nd best finish ever at nationals for the women's team which is great and higher than we were ranked in the last poll but we wanted a little higher finish. A couple of our runners had off races with one of those off races being caused by an asthma attack during the race, but our women are tough and battled through it! Our top runner just lost her Mom to cancer the week before nationals, and I thought she ran very well and her Mom would have been proud of the way she raced today! Overall, I'm very proud of our women's team this year! They are an excellent group! Go Jayhawks!"

Cross Country at the NJCAA Region XII & MCCAA Championship hosted by LCC October 31, 2015 @ TBD

The 20th-ranked Muskegon Community College women's cross country team celebrated Halloween at the Region XII and Michigan Community College Athletic Association Championships in Lansing, Michigan at Grand Woods Park. The team tied their highest regional place ever with a 4th place finish out of 14 teams with 116 points. #2-ranked Lansing CC won the meet with 24 points followed by #15-ranked Macomb CC with 83 points and #21-ranked Vincennes University with 106 points. Leading the way and earning All-Region Honors was freshman Sandy Kunnen (Fremont HS/Fremont, MI) taking 15th place out of 64 finishers running a season-best time of 20:05.
