MCC tied the game in the 5th inning on a Gage Andrews (Gaylord St. Marys HS) double to make it 7-7. In the bottom of the 6th Jon Henry (Ajax HS, Ontario) singled on a 1-2 count, driving in 2 runs and MCC held on for the victory. The Jayhawks finished with 11 hits with Andrews finishing 3-3.
