Bowling NJCAA National Tournament

The Muskegon Community College Bowling teams wrapped up the 2020-2021 season by competing over 3 days at the NJCAA National Tournament at Royal Scot Lanes in Lansing, MI.

For the Men's "All Events" Ethan May (Ravenna HS) was 27th and Jonathan Garland (Grand Haven HS) was 34th.
