Bowling NJCAA National Tournament

The Muskegon Community College Bowling teams wrapped up the 2020-2021 season by competing over 3 days at the NJCAA National Tournament at Royal Scot Lanes in Lansing, MI.

In the Women's "All Events" (out of 63 bowlers) which combined singles, doubles, and team, for a 12-game total the Jayhawk's top performer with Amaya Guzman (Ravenna HS) who finished 15th. Lindsay Cross (Mona Shores HS) finished 22nd and Morgan Foster (Oakridge HS) finished 31st. In the Women's Singles event Kennadi Dykstra (Fruitport HS) finished 16th and Foster was 19th.
