Women's Bowling Team qualifies for NJCAA National tournament

The Men's and Women's Jayhawk Bowling Teams competed in The NJCAA Region XII tournament at Royal Scot Bowling Center in Lansing.

The championship format was 3 doubles games, 3 singles games, 2 team games, 8 Baker games and total pins.

The Women's Team rallied to finish runner up and qualify for the NJCAA National Tournament. With 2 Baker games to go, MCC was down by a single pin but they rallied to secure second place by 12 pins. The team was led by Lindsay Cross (Mona Shores) who finished in 5h place and earned a spot on the All-Region XII team. Jessica Plichta (Fruitport) finished 9th in all events and Kennadi Dykstra (Fruitport) finished 14th in all events. In singles it was Cross in 4th and Plichta in 5th. Amaya Guzman (Ravenna) and Dykstra finished 9th in doubles.

The Men's team finished in 7th place overall, led by Ethan May (Ravenna) in 12th in All Events. Logan Pollack (Western Michigan Christian) finished in 12th place in singles, followed by May in 13th, Cade Alderink (Reeths-Puffer) in 14th and Shawn Murphy (Fremont) in 16th.

Bowling at Kellogg Community College Invitational-M66 Bowl

Women's team finishes 2nd, Men's team finishes 3rd at M-66.

The Jayhawk Bowling teams travelled to Battle Creek for the Kellogg Community College Invite at the M-66 Bowl. The women's team continued their streak of 2nd place finishes and the men's team finished 3rd. The award for high game of the day were both Jayhawks; Lindsay Cross (Mona Shores) with a 233 and Lee Farber (Orchard View) with a 254.

For the Women's team, Alexis Morgan (Grand Haven) finished 2nd overall with a 582 series, followed by Jayden Sheehy (Whitehall) in 3rd at 569 and Cross in 4th at 568. Jessica Plichta (Fruitport) finished 8th with a 518.

In the men's competition, Ravenna's Ethan May rolled a perfect 300 game in route to an overall 3rd place finish for the team. May finished 2nd overall with a 707 series.
