Men's Basketball Earns 15th Seed at National Championship Tournament

Muskegon Community College has been awarded the 15th seed in the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) 2022 Division II Men's Basketball Championship Tournament being held March 15-19 at Mary Miller Center in Danville, IL. The seeds were announced by the NJCAA on Tuesday afternoon.

MCC will be making its second trip in three years to nationals, although 2019-20 Jayhawk team was seeded third but never competed because the tournament was cancelled in response to the coronavirus. Prior to that, MCC last played in the national tournament during the 1989-90 season.

The Jayhawks, who are 19-8 and winners of the Great Lakes A District, open play at 2 p.m. (ET) on March 15 against #2 seed Davidson-Davie (NC), which owns a 30-2 record and won the South Atlantic A District. That winner meets the Henry Ford CC vs. Niagara County (NY) winner at 7:30 pm (ET) on March 16. The semifinals will be held March 18 and the championship game on March 19.

“We are excited for the opportunity, excited about the seeding, and looking forward to getting to work,” said MCC Head Coach Jimmy Booth.

The Jayhawk Men's Basketball team made history as they defeated Lansing Community College 92-84 to win the NJCAA Great Lakes District A for the second time in the last 3 years. The win qualifies MCC for the NJCAA National Tournament to be held in Danville, IL beginning on Tuesday, 3/15.

The game proved to be a game of runs with the Jayhawks building an early 13-point lead with just under 13 minutes to go and Lansing answering with a run of their own for a 45-36 half time lead. MCC started the second half with another 9-point run to pull close and the game would remain back and forth until the final 5 minutes when MCC pulled away with some key baskets and free throws.

"I'm so proud of this team, they all have sacrificed so much and have put this team first," said Head Coach Jimmy Booth. "This is a special group of guys."

MCC was led by Jeff Sultzer (T.C. Howe) with 23 points. DJ Lanier (Dowagiac) scored 18 points and grabbed 7 rebounds, Jarvin Graham (Prospectives) scored 16 points and Jake Martinson (Big Rapids) recorded a double-double with 15 points and 12 rebounds. Isaac Anderson (Northrop) grabbed a game high 16 boards and added 8 assists.

MCC is now 19-8 on the year. More info will be coming soon on the NJCAA National Tournament schedule.
