Getting Started Checklist

STEP 1: Admissions

- Fill out an Online Application at <u>www.muskegoncc.edu/apply</u>
- Submit an official high school or GED transcript sent directly from your high school. If possible, please include ACT/SAT scores. Questions may be directed to <u>admissions@muskegoncc.edu</u>
- Transfer your credits from previous institutions that you have attended. Please request your official college transcripts to be sent to: Transfer Evaluation, Room 1048-H, with above address. Questions may be directed to officeoftheregistrar@muskegoncc.edu.

Step 2: Financial Aid

- Fill out the FAFSA (to apply for Financial Aid) online at <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u> and use MCC school code 002297.
- College guests, community guests, Early College, and Dual Enrolled students are ineligible for Financial Aid.
- You will receive an award notification via mail and MCC email. Check you *MyMCC* account often for possible notifications and/or additional requirements.

Step 3: Testing

- Take the MCC Placement Test. Call 231.777.0394 or for an appointment.
- Placement testing has been waived for Summer 2021 unless going for Nursing, Medical Assisting or Respiratory Therapy.
- Prepare for the placement test by going to <u>http://www.muskegoncc.edu/testing/mcc-placement-test</u> and scroll down to where it states "Review Materials."
- PLEASE NOTE: you may be exempt from portions of the placement test if you meet one of the following requirements:
 - Official SAT or ACT scores, and/or high school GPA
 - https://www.muskegoncc.edu/testing/mcc-placement-test/
 - Prospective Nursing Students must take the math placement test and cannot use college credits to waive the reading test.

Step 4: New Student Orientation

- Schedule an orientation at <u>www.muskegoncc.edu/orientation</u>.
- Orientation is <u>mandatory</u> for all students seeking a degree of certificate from MCC including transfer students with fewer than 12 credits.
- Early College, please speak with your Counselor/Dean regarding orientation.

Step 5: Counseling

- Please make sure steps 1 and 3 are completed before you meet with a counselor.
