- Submit a Concurrent Enrollment Form each semester if enrolling at a Community College
- Submit FAFSA annually starting October
- Fall and Winter Registration opens mid-March
- 0% drop date typically occurs within first week of each semester. If you make changes to your schedule, contact your Academic Advisor
- Payment deadline is typically 2 weeks prior to semester beginning – Payment plans are available
- Graduation requires a 2.0 cumulative GPA or higher
- Individual curriculum guide plan subject to change with advisor consultation

Advising Details:

Potential GVSU KCON RN to BSN applicants considering the concurrent enrollment pathway should contact the KCON Office of Student Services upon acceptance into MCC's Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program.

General Admission Criteria:

Students apply online as a degree-seeking RN-BSN student using the GVSU Office of Admissions Undergraduate application. To determine when to apply, individual students should first meet with a KCON Office of Student Services Advisor. Admission to the program requires a minimum grade of "C (2.0)" in each pre-requisite course and a minimum GPA of 3.0 overall. Academic performance for the last 15 credits may be considered. Please contact the KCON assigned advisor with questions regarding how GPA is calculated.

MCC ADN students admitted to the KCON RN-BSN program will enroll in sessions at GVSU while simultaneously completing the MCC ADN program. Students will be required to register and pay tuition and fees at each respective institution when concurrently enrolled.

Students will be eligible to continue enrollment in the KCON RN-BSN program upon graduation from the ADN program at MCC and the successful completion of all other KCON RN-BSN program prerequisites including, but not limited to, a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher at graduation from the ADN program, a grade of 2.5 or higher in each ADN required nursing course, and completion of all other prerequisite course work. Prior to enrollment in the 400-level nursing courses in the KCON RN-BSN program, the student must complete and maintain comprehensive health compliance obligations. Evidence of active unrestricted RN licensure in Michigan is also required before beginning the 400-level courses in the KCON RN-BSN program.

Michigan Transfer Agreement:

Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) satisfies Grand Valley's General Education Foundations, Writing 150, and one Supplemental Writing Skills course. Students transferring with a MTA are still required to complete one SWS course in the major or division as part of GVSU requirements. In the KCON RN to BSN program, NUR 411 is designated as an SWS course. In addition, students must fulfill the two-course Cultural Emphasis requirement, and two Issues courses within the General Education Program. Students should



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complete a MTA audit at the community college in order to get the MTA STAMP on the official transcript. Students are responsible for ordering/obtaining official transcripts after completing their courses at the community college.

Required Clinical Experiences:

GVSU KCON coordinates clinical experiences within the student's geographic area of residence. For more information, contact the KCON Office of Student Services.

Program Cost:

GVSU tuition costs are available on the GVSU Financial Aid Office website at www.gvsu.edu/financialaid/. Additional tuition charges per credit hour for 200 level and above NUR courses for undergraduate students apply. Books, uniforms, transportation, etc. are not included in tuition.
