

Course Placement Flowchart

ENG-101 (English Composition I): The English course required in most MCC degree programs, which may be taken with or without the RDG-090 corequisite support course

RDG-090 (Integrated Reading and Writing): The corequisite support course designed to provide additional support to students taking ENG-101; may only be taken alongside ENG-101 (during the same semester)

ENG-102 (English Composition II): The English Composition course that follows ENG-101; students must first complete ENG-101 with a grade of C or higher (or have ENG-101 credit through AP, CLEP, etc.) before taking ENG-102
