^{*} The IPEDS (Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System) 150% graduation rate is the percentage of full-time first-time degree-seeking undergraduate students who complete their program within 150% of the normal time. For example, for an associate's degree, the normal time is typically 2 years, so the 150% graduation rate considers associate's degree students who complete within 3 years. First-time students are attending college for the first time following high school graduation.
