

Requesting **GED** Transcript

GED transcripts can only be considered official if sent directly from the school, www.diplomasender.com or www.ged.com to Muskegon Community College.

We cannot accept transcripts when they are emailed, mailed or hand delivered to MCC directly from the the student.

Step 1 – Choose an Online Service

You can use online platforms for transcript requests. Both require you to pay a fee. When entering the recipient, be sure to list Muskegon Community College (and not the student):

- Visit www.ged.com to find your state's GED testing office.
- Visit www.diplomasender.com as an alternative option to request GED transcripts.

Step 2 – Request Your GED Transcript

- **Online Request:** Many states allow you to request your GED transcript online through their GED office website (see step 1).
- **Complete the Application:** Fill out the necessary details and provide identification (if requested).

Step 3 – Alternative Methods

- **Mail or Fax:** Check for mail or fax request options if online methods are not available.
- **Contact Testing Center:** If you remember where you took the GED test, reach out to that center for assistance. They can email GED transcripts to admissions@muskegoncc.edu or mail to:
